### Crow Creek Community Garden

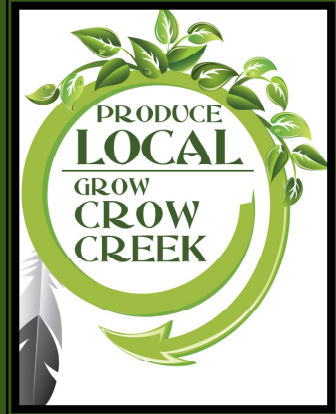
